

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy explains how PSA Canada collects, uses, stores, and protects personal information of its players, parents/guardians, coaches, and staff. The Academy is committed to safeguarding individual privacy and ensuring transparency in all data handling practices.

1. Purpose of the Policy

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all personal information collected by PSA Canada is handled responsibly and in compliance with applicable privacy laws.

2. What Information Is Collected

PSA Canada may collect the following:

- Player names, birthdates, addresses
- Parent/guardian contact details
- Emergency contact info
- Medical information (allergies, conditions)
- Photos and videos for promotional use

3. How Information Is Used

Personal information is used solely for:

- Registration and team assignments
- Emergency communication
- Scheduling and attendance
- Reporting to soccer associations
- Promotional and media purposes (with consent)

4. Consent and Parental Permission

Parents/guardians must provide written consent during registration to share medical details, emergency contacts, and allow participation in media. No child's data will be used without explicit permission.

5. Photo, Video, and Media Use

Photos or videos taken during Academy events may be used for marketing, website, or social media. Parents may opt out of media inclusion by submitting a written request.



6. Access to and Storage of Information

Only authorized staff have access to personal information. Data is stored securely in password-protected systems or locked files. Hard copies are kept in restricted areas.

7. Disclosure to Third Parties

PSA Canada does not sell or share personal data with third parties unless required by law or for player registration with official soccer bodies (e.g., Ontario Soccer).

8. Withdrawal of Consent

Parents or individuals may withdraw consent for use of their personal data at any time by emailing psacanada2024@gmail.com. Withdrawal will not affect previous lawful usage.

9. Security Measures

We take reasonable steps to protect personal information using physical, technical, and administrative safeguards. Staff are trained on data protection best practices.
